INDIAN CORN FAVOR TUTORIAL

Stamps: A Little Something

Inks: Real Red, Crumb Cake, Chocolate Chip

Cardstock: Crumb Cake, Hello Honey

Accessories: Leaflet Framelits, Linen Thread, Gold Glimmer Paper, 1/8" Hole Punch, Sponge Daubers, Bone Folder

Non-SU: Pretzel Bags, M&Ms



Step 1: Cut Crumb Cake cardstock to 3 x 11. Break down fibers in cardstock by running bone folder across it several times.



Step 2: Twist one end to form a point.



Step 3: Cut 1/2" slits in cardstock on opposite end from point side.



Step 4: Fill Pretzel Bags halfway full with M&Ms. Tie closed with Linen Thread. Cut off excess bag top and Linen Thread.



Step 5: Place M&M bag inside point. (Ignore that I hadn't made the cuts yet here. lol!)



Step 6: Hold pretzel bag in place and gather all the cut ends together and tie with more Linen Thread, leave long enough to tie a bow.



Step 7: Decorate! Sponge Crumb Cake ink over cut strips and around husk and point. Cut Hello Honey cardstock and Gold Glimmer Paper with Leaflet Framelits. Stamp A Little Something greeting with Chocolate Chip Ink on leaf. Sponge Real Red around larger leaf. Punch hole in larger leaf with 1/8" Circle Punch and add Gold Glimmer leaf to larger leaf with Stampin' Dimensional. Tie leaf onto Indian Corn favor with ends of the Linen Thread and tie a bow.
